Elias John Manolis was born in Manganiti, Ikaria, Greece on March 10, 1922 to John and Anastasia Manolis, and passed away on April 1, 2012. He served in the Merchant Marines during WWII and was held captive under the German occupation. He is survived by sons and daughter, John, Alexander and Anastasia Manolis Feola.
