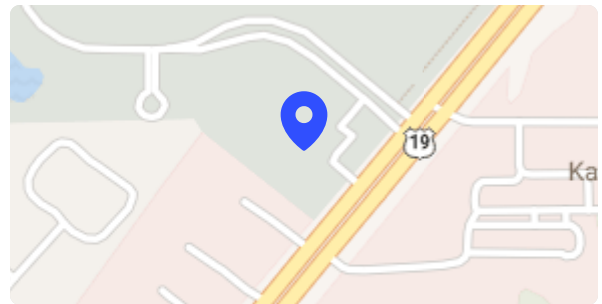

Chris Baker posted:

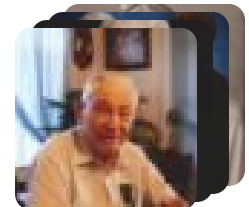
