**G**eorge "Bud" S. Geyer, 87, of Hudson, FL passed away peacefully on Friday, March 22nd, 2019. George was born in Renick, West Virginia to Russell and Susie Geyer on October 12th, 1931 and was a Christian by faith.

George graduated from Berea College in Kentucky as an Agriculture major, then joined the Army in 1954, where he served as a Food Inspector while stationed in Germany. He was employed by the Oakland County Health Department as a Sanitarian for many years until his retirement. 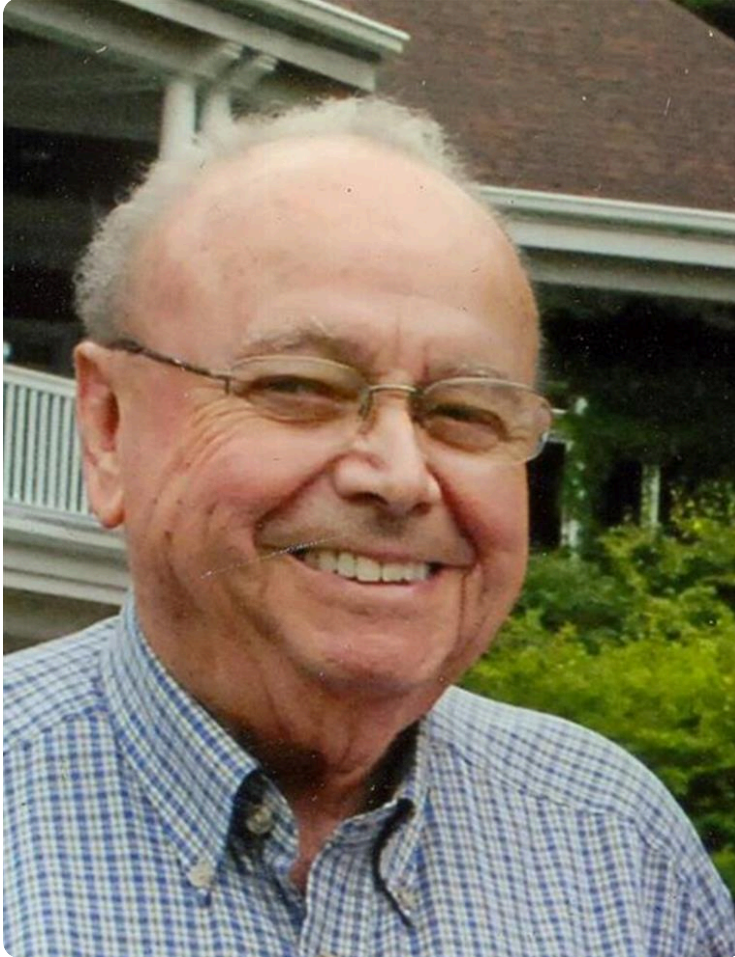
