Rosalyn Quinones was born Rosalyn Florence Perpignan on September 6th 1938 and passed away peacefully at home in San Antonio, Florida on November 9th 2019 at the age of 81 years.

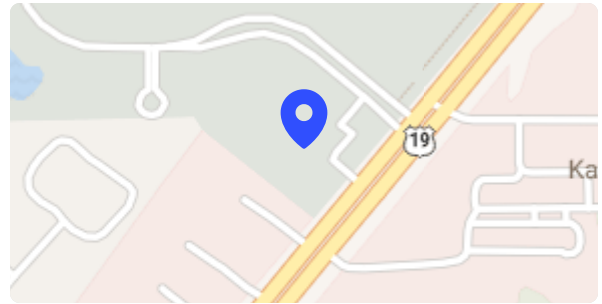

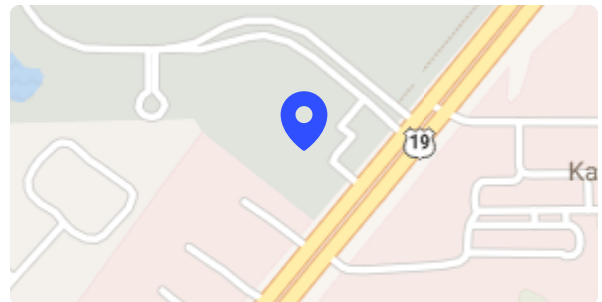
