Nicholas Joseph Bonaimo, 85, of Hudson, FL passed away peacefully on Tuesday (February 15th, 2022) at Bayonet Point Regional Medical Center. Nick was born in Brooklyn, NY on July 14th, 1936 and faithfully served as a decorated Sergeant in the United States Marine Corps in Korea. He retired in 1992 from AT&T after years of working in the telecommunications industry. Nick was a devoted and long-standing member of St. Michael's Catholic Church and volunteered with many service organizations including The Knights of Columbus where he was a 4th Degree member, The Fraternal Order of Eagles, and The Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks. After his retirement, Nick worked as an assistant for Grace Memorial Gardens & Funeral Home and served as Vice President of Lakeside Woodlands Civic Association for over 27-years.

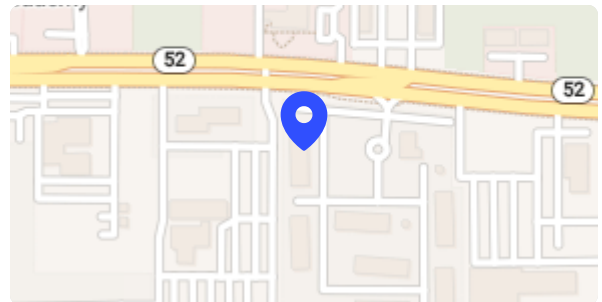
