As a beloved member of an extensive family, Joan leaves behind her husband of 52 years Robert C. 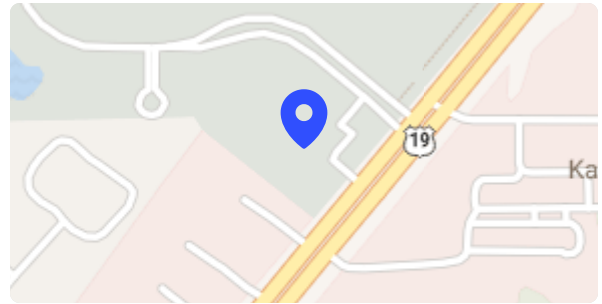
