Grace Memorial Gardens and Funeral Home is honored to assist Bob's family with his final arrangements.

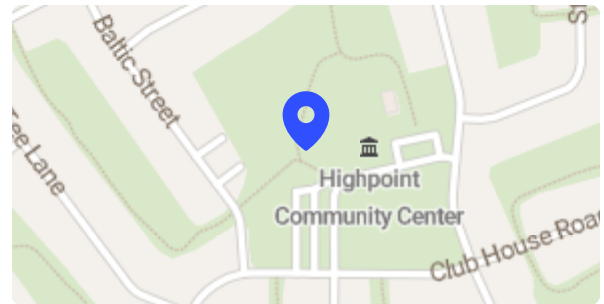
