**T**od James Kilroy, 85, passed away peacefully on April 11, 2026. He was the devoted husband of Paula Kilroy, with whom he shared nearly fifty wonderful years of marriage filled with love, companionship, and countless memories.

Tod was born on December 25, 1940, in Lockport, New York, to the late James Raymond Kilroy and Clare Kilroy (née Ritzenthaler). Tod graduated from Michigan State University with a Bachelor of Science. Later returning to earn his Masters in Urban Planning in 1987. He built a long and fulfilling career as a city planner, dedicating forty years of service to thoughtful development and community improvement.

Tod found joy in life's simple pleasures. He had a lifelong appreciation for antique cars and proudly owned several over the years, including a 1950 Ford, a 1969 Chevy, and a Buick Riviera. He loved being on the water and enjoyed boating whenever he could, as well as camping and spending time outdoors. At home, Tod was always working on projects or tackling repairs, finding satisfaction in building, fixing, and improving his surroundings. 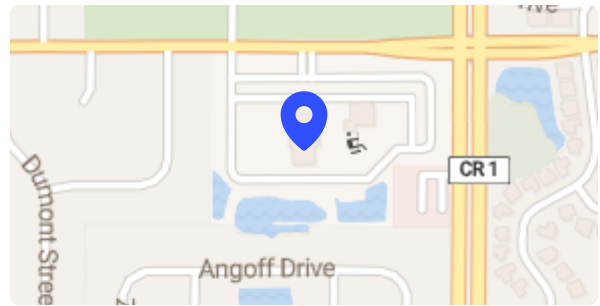
